ORDER

Grading System has been introduced to all PG programmes under CSS with the introduction of Regulations for Post Graduate Programmes in the Teaching Departments of University of Kerala (2017).

Complaints regarding the Grading System have been received from PG students of some Departments stating that in the Grading System grade point is fixed in the lower limit of class interval except in the highest class, leading to the reduction in percentage.

The meeting of the CSS Academic Committee vide paper read (1) above recommended to constitute a subcommittee to study and submit a report in the next CSSAC meeting.

The CSS Academic Committee vide paper read (2) above discussed the report submitted by the subcommittee and recommended to implement the revised grading system w.e.f 2019 admissions, as detailed below, as proposed by the subcommittee.

Course wise Grading

Conversion of Percentage of marks into grade points of a course is as follows:

- 1. Results declared for the 17-19 batch PG programmes of all Departments be cancelled.
- 2. HoDs be requested to resubmit the results in the new grading pattern already approved.
- 3. HoDs be authorized to collect the Grade Cards, Consolidated Mark sheets, Provisional Certificates and Position Certificates issued to students of 17-19 batch and 18-20 batch and to hand over the same to the CSS.
- **4.** New Grade Cards and Certificates shall be issued as and when the already issued Grade Cards and Certificates are surrendered.

The above recommendations of the CSS Academic Committee were approved by the Vice-Chancellor.

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor to implement the revised Grading System w.e.f 2017 admission as detailed above.
